## **FIANS Bursary**

The FIANS bursary is awarded annually to support the post secondary education efforts of the children of our regular members. The amount awarded is \$1000 and the money is released to the successful applicant once confirmation of school registration is received by FIANS.

### **Guidelines and criteria**

Applicants must complete a registration form and on the form must identify that their guardian / parent is a regular member of FIANS.

Applicants must be pursuing post secondary or graduate studies (university, college, community college or other approved program). The school program must be identified in the application.

Applications must be received by April 1st of each year and should be forwarded to the Administrative Assistant of FIANS at the address indicated on the application form.

The Administrative Assistant of FIANS will review all applications to ensure that they are compliant with the criteria.

All qualified applicants will have their name entered in a draw at the spring conference. Two names are selected at this time - the first name being the winner and the second name being drawn as a backup.

Bursary money is released once confirmation of school registration is received by the Administrative Assistant of FIANS.

Applications are not renewable and must be submitted each year. The name of the current bursary award winner will not be included in the next year's draw unless they are the only applicant.

The bursary winner and his/her guardian/parent will be invited to the fall conference dinner where the cheque will be presented.
